## School Community Council MINUTES *DRAFT* December 19, 2023 7:30 am

- 1. Welcome and Approval of Minutes
  - a. Principal McNaughtan welcomed members to the meeting and thanked them for their attendance. David Kingg motioned to approve the minutes of the September 28 meeting. Melanie Sues seconded the motion with all members present voting in favor.
- 2. ACADIENCE Data Grades K-2 (formerly DIBLES)
  - a. Principal McNaughtan explained to council members some of the vocabulary from our instructional teaching.
    - i. Time vs Learning: Because we all learn at different rates, teachers focus on making sure students have the time and opportunities they need to understand concepts being taught.
    - ii. Tier 1: Where teachers are teaching the whole class.
    - iii. Tier 2 WINN (What I Need to Know): Teachers divide students into groups according to skills. Teachers use this time to target specific skills students have not yet mastered.
    - iv. Tier 3: For students who need another opportunity to master skills. Instruction is provided by our intervention teacher and para professionals.
  - b. Principal McNaughtan showed the comparisons of grades K-2 beginning of year and middle of year scores. Shauna Goates, intervention teacher, explained the acadience reading measures by grade level. She presented the data showing the growth our intervention students have made.
    - i. David Kingg asked if there was a way to tell which students are new to the school. Lori Crook mentioned that third grade uses the DAZE assessment where a student reads a passage with a missing word and they have to fill in the blank with the correct word. ColleenTolles, a teacher at the high school, commented on how valuable it is that a student be reading at grade level. She complemented teachers on their hard work. Kathy Hayter commented how some students have mastered the skills but are unable to finish in the allotted time.
    - ii. Principal McNaughtan will discuss the second grade goals and their plan to implement.
- 3. Budget and Information for Members
  - a. Principal McNaughtan gave a brief update of the budget. He also showed members where to access information regarding school land trust.
- 4. Meeting dates for the remainder of the school year will be March 5, 2024 and April 16, 2024.
- 5. Duke DiStefano motioned to dismiss the meeting; Breanna Quinn seconded the motion with all members present voting in favor.
