1. Welcome and Approval of Minutes
 - a. Principal McNaughtan welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked them for their willingness to serve on the council. He then asked for a motion to accept the minutes of the April 10, 2025 meeting. Adam Johnson motioned to accept the minutes; Jen Gogan seconded the motion with all members present voting in favor.
2. Nominations for Chair and Vice Chair
 - a. Principal McNaughtan explained the responsibilities of the chair and vice chair and asked for nominations for chair. Principal McNaughtan nominated Kristen Blum for the position of chair. Jen Gogan seconded the motion with everyone present voting in favor. Kristen Blum nominated Adam Johnson for vice chair. Amanda Crowe seconded the motion, and all members present voted in favor.
3. Member Emails
 - a. Principal McNaughtan explained that members' emails are published on the school website. Members are given the option of having a district email or using their own personal email. 5. Budget and Goals for 2025-26
 - a. Principal McNaughtan explained to the council members how the SLT Plan for 2025-26 was written last spring. The funds received from SLT will be used to fund an intervention teacher. The goal for this year is to increase scores school wide by three percent.
