**Excel Time:** Excel Time is a program here at WHS that will allow teachers to reteach and help those students who have not mastered the essential skills of a particular course. And, while some students will be requested to work with specific teachers, others will be able to choose from an offering of academic enrichments. Every student will have a place to go during Excel time, and every student is required to attend.

## COLLEGE CREDIT OPTIONS



**Concurrent Enrollment (CE):** These classes are taught at WHS by WHS teachers, on a black/gold schedule. They are offered for college credit to students who apply with UVU as a concurrent enrollment high school student and enroll in the courses by the deadlines. Utah Valley University's concurrent office can be reached at 801863-8376. There is a \$35 one-time application fee. The charge is \$5 per credit hour. There is a minimum GPA requirement for all CE course: 3.0 for academic courses and 2.0 for CTE courses.

**Distance Learning Classes:** These are general education college courses, taught by a UVU professor, broadcast live and interactive at WHS. These courses are available to Juniors and Seniors. More information will be given in your 10<sup>th</sup> grade PCCR.

**Advanced Placement (AP):** These courses are considered to be the most rigorous at WHS. We offer 17 courses that will push students learning to the next level, with this challenging curriculum. To earn college credit, a student is required to pass the end of year AP test. AP Biology and Calculus are dual enrollment courses meaning you can sign up for CE credit as well as take the AP test. The fee is \$96 per test. College credit is awarded differently at each university. Check with your chosen college to see how they grant AP credit.

**Mountainland Technical College (mtec.edu):** MTECH is something to look forward to for Junior and Senior year. The best way to prepare is take related high school courses in the area of interest. You can browse programs by visiting this link.

# Opportunity Scholarship

The Opportunity Scholarship will be available to students beginning with the high school graduating class of 2022.

## Requirements:

- Earn a 3.3 cumulative high school GPA
- Complete 3 advanced courses
  - Complete 1 Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB)\*, or Concurrent Enrollment (CE) course in each of the core areas of high school graduation:
    - **math,**
    - **science, and**
    - **language arts**
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Graduate from a Utah high school

## Making Up Failed Credit



At Wasatch an “F” is considered failing. Any “F” earned in a required course for graduation must be make up. Options include:

**Teacher Credit Recovery**- If a student has earned at least a 50%, they should meet with their teacher to determine a specific plan to recover the credit. This is the primary recovery plan we recommend students use.

**Eschool Credit Recovery**- Credit recovery is completed in an online curriculum, completing a shortened version of the course. You **MUST** first meet with your counselor to receive a referral form to sign up to do credit recovery. Doing a credit recovery course will **NOT** take the “F” off of your transcript, but it will give you the credit you need for graduation. If you want to replace your grade, you will need to do a Grade Replacement

**Grade Replacement**- You can replace a grade in a class by either: taking that course again in person, or if available, you can take that entire term of that course online through WHS eschool. You will need to meet with your counselor to set up these options in your schedule.

**Summer School**- More information will be on the counseling website in the spring.

**Wasatch Alternative School**- This program is reserved for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students at high risk of not graduating. A student must be formally referred by a WHS main campus counselor in order to participate in alternative school.
