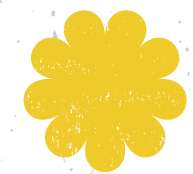
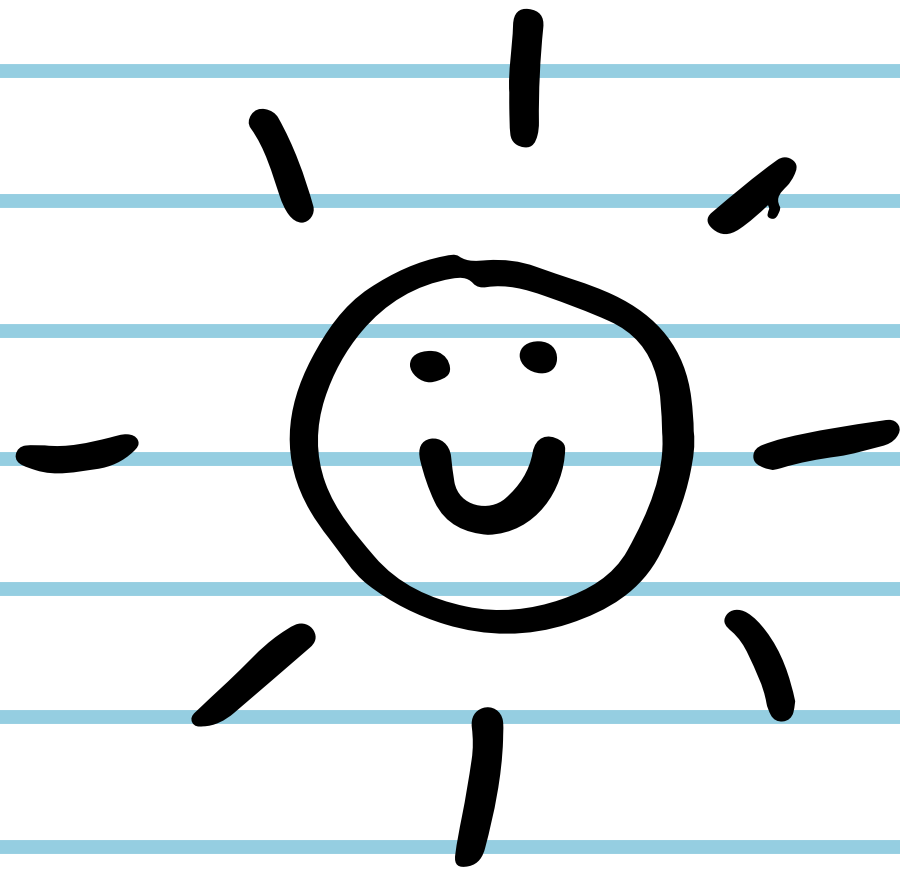

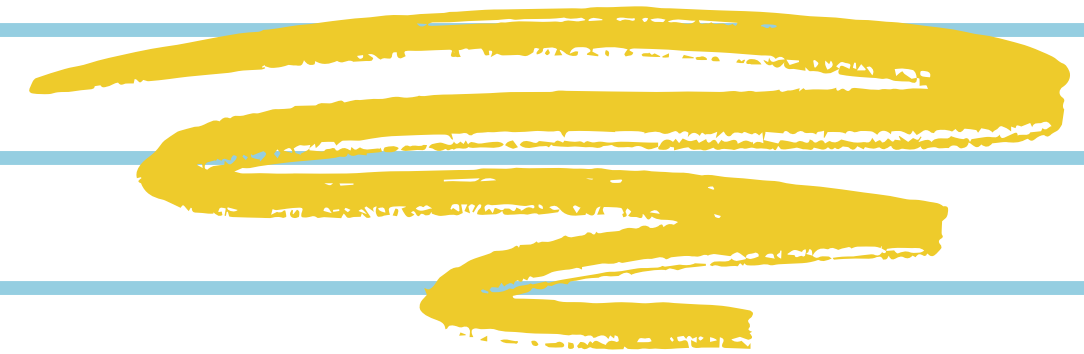

Attendance (GO TO SCHOOL)

Attendance Quick Reference Guide



Teacher: Daily Task (every class period) Take attendance promptly at the start of class

Bell – 10 minutes late	10-20 minutes late	21+ minutes late
Teacher: T is marked in attendance	<p>Teacher: Sends student to the office for a tardy slip. The office will provide a slip with the time the student checked in.</p> <p>Teacher: Change attendance to a Y if 11-20 minutes is circled on the tardy slip.</p>	<p>Teacher: Sends student to the office for a tardy slip. The office will provide a slip with the time the student checked in.</p> <p>Teacher: There is no need to change attendance. 21+ minutes late remains an X.</p>

End of Term: How to calculate UA's?

****Remember to use the Attendance Page to calculate attendance marks– NOT THE GRADE PAGE.**

UA = More than 3 unexcused absences (X)

UA = More than 5 tardies (T or Y)

UA = Sluff

Making up Failed Credit



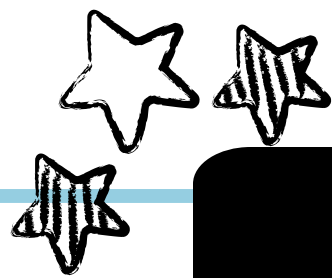
If a student receives an F in any required course for graduation, they must make it up! Here's how:

- 1 Teacher Credit Recovery**
If student earned at least a 50%
- 2 Eschool Credit Recovery**
Can be built into schedule or done independently; online curriculum
- 3 Grade Replacement**
Online curriculum done independently OR student may repeat the in-person class
- 4 Summer School**
For credit recovery only, original credit is not available

Live Interactive

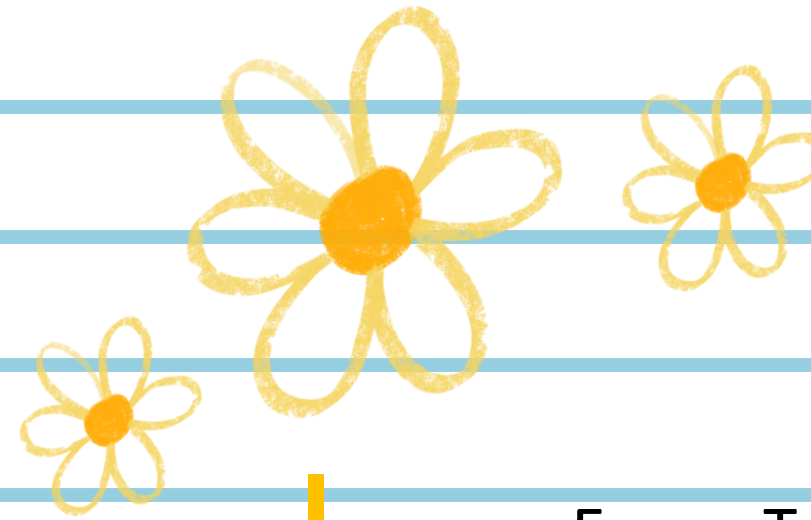

Prime Scholarship

- Earn a Transform Certificate
- Complete FAFSA

To earn a TRANSFORM Certificate a student must complete one of the following options:

1- complete 5 C.E. courses in 5 different gen ed categories **OR**

2- 6 courses or 300 hours in CTE program at a Utah Technical college **OR**

3- complete a youth apprenticeship

Can be applied to any Utah public institution (traditional) + BYU-Provo and Westminster, Ensign

College, Western Governor's Univ. + any public Utah Technical College *one-time award, \$500

PATHWAYS

- A recognition program, no scholarship attached to the CTE pathway program
- Must earn 3.0 in a concentrated area
- Must complete the required focus, concentrator and completer courses as outlined in the pathway

NCAA

- Must register at eligibilitycenter.org
- Must complete 16 NCAA eligible core courses
- Must meet with your counselor to review your transcript and plan

ESCHOOL

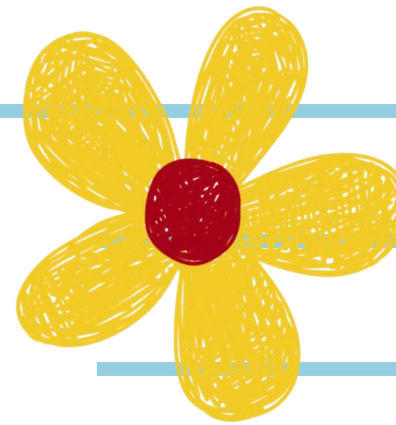
- Core classes and electives are available online
- Students may take one class or up to their full schedule online
- Course deadlines follow term deadlines
- Edgenuity, video-based, with teacher support
- Students may have a free period in exchange for taking an online class
- Students may take a full schedule plus two online classes
