


Attendance (GO TO SCHOOL)

Attendance Quick Reference Guide



Teacher: Daily Task (every class period) Take attendance promptly at the start of class

Bell – 10 minutes late	10-20 minutes late	21+ minutes late
Teacher: T is marked in attendance	Teacher: Sends student to the office for a tardy slip. The office will provide a slip with the time the student checked in.	Teacher: Sends student to the office for a tardy slip. The office will provide a slip with the time the student checked in.
	Teacher: Change attendance to a Y if 11-20 minutes is circled on the tardy slip.	Teacher: There is no need to change attendance. 21+ minutes late remains an X.

End of Term: How to calculate UA's?

**Remember to use the Attendance Page to calculate attendance marks- NOT THE GRADE PAGE.

UA = More than 3 unexcused absences (X)

UA = More than 5 tardies (T or Y)

UA = Sluff

Making up Failed Credit

If a student receives an F in any required course

for graduation, they must make it up! Here's how:

1 Teacher Credit Recovery

If student earned at least a 50%

2 Eschool Credit Recovery

Can be built into schedule or done independently; online curriculum

3 Grade Replacement

Online curriculum done independently OR student may repeat the in-person class

4 Summer School

For credit recovery only, original credit is not available



- 3- complete a youth apprecticeship





- Must register st eligibilitycenter.org
- Must complete 16
 NCAA eligible core courses
- Must meet with your counselor to review your transcript and plan

- Core classes and electives are available online
- Students may take one class or up to their full schedule online
- Course deadlines follow term deadlines
- Edgenuity, video-based, with teacher support
- Students may have a free period in exchange for taking an online class
- Students may take a full schedule plus two online classes
