For students interested in attending college, English 1010 or AP English is recommended during high school. For juniors, English 1010 DOES NOT include ACT preparation while AP English does. English 1010, 1010/2010 and 2010 are concurrent enrollment classes taught in-person by WHS English teachers. Students will receive high school and college credit through UVU for the class. Students can also earn college credit through AP English and AP Literature by passing an AP exam at the end of the school year.

How do I Qualify to take Concurrent Enrollment English Classes?

English 1010

- Accuplacer Placement Exam score (250+ in English & 250+ in Reading) **OR**
- ACT score of 19+ in English and 19+ in Reading **OR** have an ACT score of 20+ in English and 18+ in Reading **OR** have and ACT score of 18+ in English and 20+ in Reading.

English 1010/2010

- Accuplacer Placement Exam score (250+ in English & 250+ in Reading) **OR**
- ACT score of 19+ in English and 19+ in Reading **OR** have an ACT score of 20+ in English and 18+ in Reading **OR** have and ACT score of 18+ in English and 20+ in Reading.

English 2010

- Pass the ENGL LANG AP TEST with a 3+ and add UVU to your College Board account so UVU will have your scores to allow you to register.
- Have an ACT Score of 29+ in English and Reading

Where can I take the Accuplacer EXAM?

- At the UVU testing center in Orem
- At Wasatch High School in the Library Lecture Hall on the following dates :
 - 10th Graders:
 - Monday, February 3 (Sign up by Jan. 27)
 - Monday, February 28 (Sign up by Feb. 18)
 - 11th Graders:
 - Monday, April 14 (Sign up by April 9)
 - Friday, April 18 (Sign up by April 14)
 - Monday, April 28 (Sign up by April 21)

How much does it cost?

- At UVU Testing Center: \$23.50 both sections; \$11.50 one section (pay when you register)
- WHS: \$20 both sections; \$10 one section (Your WHS student account will be charged after you take the exam. If you are on a fee waiver, there will be no charge.)

How do I register?

- To take the Accuplacer exam, you must have a UVU ID and sign up for the exam ahead of time.
- The WHS testing sessions can only accommodate 20 students for each testing time.
- Specific steps on how to register are on the following page.

Can I retake the Accuplacer Exam?

Yes, you can retake the Accuplacer EXAM up to 3 times within a 3-week period, with each attempt being at least one day apart. You can retake just one section of the exam, if needed.

ACCUPLACER Registration Info

Creating a UVU ID:

- Apply to UVU Concurrent Enrollment. (If you have taken a concurrent enrollment class, you already have a UVUID and don't need to re-apply).
 - To apply to UVU concurrent enrollment, follow Step 1 on this link: <https://www.uvu.edu/concurrent/>
 - You will need to know your social security number. If you do not have a social security number, please type in 000-00-0000.

Use your UVUID@uvu.edu to log in and your UVU password. DO NOT TRY TO LOG IN WITH YOUR WASATCH EMAIL AND PASSWORD- IT WON'T WORK. If you don't know your UVU ID or are having trouble logging in, please call the UVU help desk at (801)863-8888.

Registering for the ACCUPLACER Exam at WHS

STEP 1: SIGN UP FOR EXAM with UVU at <https://www.registerblast.com/uvu/Exam/List>.

1. From the first drop-down, select "I am a UVU student."
2. From the second drop-down, SCROLL TO THE END and select "Wasatch High School." (It will be one of the last options.)
3. From the third drop-down, select "Wasatch High School- ACCUPLACER – English Placement."
4. From the fourth drop-down, select "Accuplacer- Both Sections."
5. Complete all of the required student information.
6. Review the information in the "Exam guidelines acknowledgement" section and check the box next to "I agree to follow the above guidelines."
8. Click "Add to Cart."
9. You will be directed to a new page.
10. You will be redirected to the payment screen. You do not need to pay anything on this website.
11. Watch for an email confirming your test registration. If you do not receive a confirmation email within 30 – 60 minutes, contact 801-863-7095 to make sure your registration went through.

STEP 2: SIGN UP FOR TESTING TIME THROUGH WHS COUNSELING OFFICE

1. Visit the WHS Counseling Page at <https://wasatch.edu/whs/counseling/>
2. Click on "Schedule an Appointment" on top left corner of main page
3. Sign up for a testing time and date under "Accuplacer/ALEKS"
4. Bring a photo ID and come to library lecture hall at your scheduled testing time.

Registering for the ACCUPLACER Exam to take at UVU

STEP 1: SIGN UP FOR EXAM with UVU at <https://www.registerblast.com/uvu/Exam/List>.

1. From the first drop-down, select "I am a UVU student."
2. From the second drop-down, select "ACCUPLACER Placement Exam."
3. From the third drop-down, select "ACCUPLACER – Proctored at Testing Center."
4. From the fourth drop-down, select "Accuplacer- Both Sections (\$23.50)."
5. Choose Date that works for your schedule to take at the UVU Testing Center.
6. Choose a time.
7. Complete all of the required student information.
8. Review the information in the "Exam guidelines acknowledgement" section and check the box next to "I agree to follow the above guidelines."
0. Click "Add to Cart."
10. You will be directed to a new page.
11. You will be redirected to the payment screen. Pay the testing fee (If you need help paying for fee, please reach out to high school counselor or College Success Advisor, Kim Danley.
12. Watch for an email confirming your test registration. If you do not receive a confirmation email within 30 – 60 minutes, contact 801-863-7095 to make sure your registration went through.
