## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

\$473,400 was awarded to 290 students from class of 2024 from over 120 donors.

Most scholarships awarded are between \$500-1,000. A few specific scholarships are highlighted below.



The Wasatch CAPS Program, or Center for Advanced Professional Studies offers scholarships for students who participate in CAPS classes and meet certain requirements. Ask your CAPS instructor for more information.



The We Rise First-Generation Scholars Program awards first-generation students a renewable scholarship and mentoring during all four years of college. Priority given to students academically prepared for college determined by course rigor and GPA.



Started in 2023, the Heber Valley Chamber of Commerce awards Wasatch Works scholarships for students from WHS who have worked 600 hours at a local Wasatch County business during high school. 3.0 GPA Requirement.



Public Employees Scholarship



The Public Employees Scholarship is given to children of public service employees working in education and government agencies (i.e. teachers, law enforcement, county or government employees).

Applications are open for ten days in March. Students apply through their SIS account and are notified through their school email.

An essay, resume, and college acceptance letter are required. Only complete applications are considered.
