PEL = Professional Educator License: Educator has a professional license and is fully qualified for the assignment

AEL = Associate Educator License: Educator has an associate license through a professional license prep program or has a professional license and is in a program to get an additional license area or endorsement to become fully qualified.

LEA-S = LEA-Specific: Educator is teaching in area that they have been approved by the local school board to teach.

No Lic = No Current License: In this case, these are special ed teachers applying for programs to qualify for their assignment; AELs should be posted by the end of the year.

Teaching Out of Area: Professionally licensed classroom educators teaching in an area where they have not completed all the requirements to be considered 'qualified' by USBE for that subject. This includes coaches teaching PE for their sport who do not have a PE endorsement, native speaking Spanish educators teaching Spanish and/or DLI who are still working on USBE endorsements, educators whose knowledge and competency stem from work experience in the subject area they're teaching, etc.
