

Criteria for Vehicle Replacement WASATCH SCHOOL DISTRICT

Purpose

To ensure safe, reliable, and cost-effective transportation for students and staff, the District establishes criteria for evaluating when district-owned vehicles should be considered for replacement or disposal.

Criteria for Vehicle Replacement

A district-owned vehicle will be recommended for replacement if **any** of the following conditions are met:

1. Mileage Threshold

• The vehicle has exceeded **100,000 miles** of documented use.

2. Age Threshold

• The vehicle is **15 years or older** from the date of manufacture.

3. Safety Concerns

• The vehicle fails to meet current safety standards or has been involved in incidents that compromise structural integrity.

4. Maintenance and Repair Costs

- Annual maintenance/repair costs exceed 30% of the vehicle's current fair market value, or
- The vehicle has had multiple major repairs (e.g., transmission, engine, brake system) within a 24-month period.

5. **Operational Reliability**

• The vehicle has had repeated breakdowns that disrupt district operations or present risk to staff/students.

6. Compliance

 The vehicle no longer meets federal/state emissions standards or cannot be made compliant at reasonable cost.
